OFFICIAL BALLOT AND INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

Please carefully read these instructions before marking and mailing your ballot. **The ballot is on the reverse side of this page.**

1) **To vote for candidates individually**, completely fill in the bubbles next to the names of the candidates of your choice; **do not** put any marks in either of the bubbles next to the slate names. Do not vote for more than the number of allowed candidates for any office. The number of candidates you are allowed to vote for is listed in the left hand column of the ballot for each office. If you vote individually for more than the allowed number of candidates for an office, your ballot will be void for that office only.

2) **To vote for a slate**, fill in the bubble next to the name of the slate of your choice. If you vote for a slate, you will have voted for all members of that slate. You cannot vote for both slates. You may vote for individual candidates for office(s) the slate of your choice does not have a full slate of candidates for. If you vote for a slate, and also fill in any bubbles for candidates not on that slate that add up to more than the allowed number of votes for that office, the slate vote will count, and votes will be credited to the candidates on that slate. The individual over-vote(s) will not count.

3) **THIS IS A SECRET BALLOT ELECTION.** Do not write your name or make any identifying marks or comments on this ballot. Information on the outside reply envelope will be used to make sure that only eligible votes are counted, but no one knows how you or anyone else voted.

4) No write-in or sticker candidates will be allowed on this ballot.

5) If you make an error marking this ballot, you may call 888-317-1906 to request a replacement ballot by leaving a recorded message.

6) Place this marked ballot in the provided Secret Ballot Sleeve, place the Secret Ballot Sleeve in the provided Reply Envelope, and mail. Postage is pre-paid, you do not need to use a stamp. Do not send via certified mail or use any method that requires a receipt signature. **DO NOT OBSCURE YOUR PREPRINTED NAME AND BARCODE FROM THE REPLY ENVELOPE. THIS INFORMATION IS NEEDED TO VERIFY ELIGIBILITY.**

The ballot must be received at our Post Office Box by 10:00 am on October 23, 2018 in order to be counted in this election. Tabulation will be held in the banquet room at 1645 West Jackson Blvd Chicago, Illinois, beginning at 11:00 am.
