A formal letter is going out in the next few hours. Here is a snapshot.

Dear Parents,

If your child is experiencing any of the symptoms of the corona virus, which are fever, coughing, respiratory issues, and severe pain, do **not** send them to school. Please take them to the doctor and provide the school with a medical note upon return. If any staff or child has contracted the corona virus, the health department will immediately notify the school district. We will immediately notify parents and community.

The School City of East Chicago has a plan in place to immediately close the schools for two weeks, provide students with an extensive ELearning curriculum, and to hire a cleaning company to thoroughly clean the building the next two weeks.

At this time, there are no reported cases of staff and students contracting the virus in East Chicago. Please frequent our school website and answer robo-calls for future information.
