Our message and our proposals to the County have been reasonable and clear:

- Increase the steps to reward longevity and experience for every SEIU Local 73 member
- Fair raises every year for every worker
- Equal pay for equal work, including differentials
- Hazard Pay and Pandemic Pay
- Affordable healthcare, including retiree health benefits
- Tuition reimbursement and increased funds for continuing education
- Pay professional and licensed staff based on professional experience or years of licensure

We will continue to meet with the County with the hope they will come to the table with proposals or ideas that meet our needs as the workers who keep Cook County running. We are not going to be dictated to by the County's stalling tactics. The County and CCH are forecasting steady revenue increases through 2026 and this doesn't even count the \$1 billion the County is getting from the Federal government
